KNOX COUNTY JUNIOR FAIR EAR TAGS

If an animal loses a tag the exhibitor needs to contact Andrea Rees or Samantha Beheler with the following information:

- Exhibitor Name
- Specie
- Tag Number Lost
- Picture of Tag

COUNTY-WIDE JUNIOR FAIR TAGGING

WHO: Dairy Market Feeders, Market Lambs, and Market Goats

WHEN: May 4, 2019 from 8:00 A.M.—11:00 A.M.

WHERE: Knox County Fairgrounds

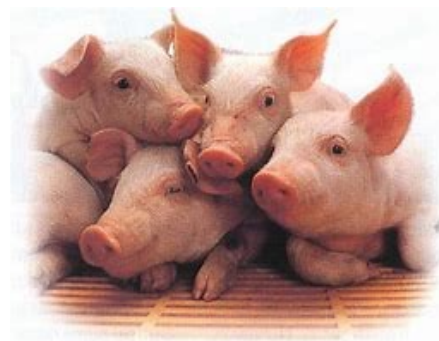
COST: Sponsored by the Knox County Sales Committee

OTHER INFO:

Dairy Market Feeders: Must be dehorned and castrated before the May tagging. Must be 100% dairy and male.

Market Lambs: All market lambs (wethers & ewes) must have valid USDA approved scrapie tag in their ear prior to the May tagging. Failure to do so will lead to those market lambs not getting a county tag. Castration of male lambs must be completed by the May tagging.

Market Goats: All market goats (wethers & does) must have valid USDA approved scrapie tag in their ear prior to the May tagging. Failure to do so will lead to those market goats not getting a county tag. All animals must be dehorned (no more than a 1 in. scur) and males must be castrated by the May tagging.



MARKET HOG PAPERWORK:

Needs to be returned to the OSU Extension Office prior to the deadline or at the Senior Fair Board Office on May 4, 2019 by 11 a.m.

No late paperwork will be accepted!
