## How Much Does Camp Cost ?

- ◇ \$180 per 4-H Camper (\$190 for non 4-H members) if reservations are received by **May 15th.**
- ◇ Spaces are available on a first-come-first-serve basis.
- ◇ Cancellations must be made by May 15th to receive a partial refund.
- ◇ Some optional activities do have an additional fee.



## What Does This Cost Include?

Camp fees include: lodging, meals, three evening snacks, accident insurance, one camp photo and three individual store snacks (\$2 limit). Additional fees are required High Ropes (\$10), or Shotgun (\$5 each). These special activities also require the camper to be 12 or older at camp.
