Camp Arrival

Cloverbuds must be signed in at day camp between 9:00 a.m. and 9:20 a.m. at the Brown Family Environmental Center that is located in Gambier on Laymon Road. There will not be supervision for campers dropped off before 9:00 a.m. The campers will need to bring a packed sack lunch and drink. They may want to bring a water bottle to use throughout the day as well. We will provide a snack and drink in the afternoon.

Camp Dismissal

Cloverbuds must be signed out before leaving when they are dismissed at 2:00 p.m. We understand that there are situations where parents have a right to restrict who will pick up their child at the end of camp. When you sign in your Cloverbud at the beginning of the day you will indicate who will be picking them up.

Who Can Attend?

Youth who are enrolled as Cloverbud for 2019 are eligible to attend. Ohio's 4-H Cloverbud Program is for youth age 5 and in kindergarten until they reach age 8 and in the third grade.
