SWOT Analysis	Students we will develop a S.W.O.T. analysis of our chapter. SWOT stands for strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats. This will better allow us to determine S.M.A.R.T. goals for our chapter this upcoming year. As we analyze our chapter also think about your strengths and how you can better each chapter member based off of your strengths.	
Review SWOT analysis	Take some time to go over the officers analysis of the chapter	
SMART goals	Now that we know the greatest feats we have to overcome this year through our analysis lets make goals that make us better as a chapter and also wil set us apart and try to make those threats go away.	
Overview of SMART goals	Take time to go over each goal and as an officer team decide which are the best for the upcoming year and how can we accomplish those.	
Review today's objective(s):	create SMART goals for the chapter	
Opportunity to Learn (Students show YOU they learned that which you planned for them to learn, i.e. a student activity, writing a paragraph, a skit, a demonstration, a quiz, etc):	Students show they learned by developing the chapters SMART goals based on the overall analysis of the chapter using the SWOT method.
