Immediate action

- Traditional Pathway BSN students:** Accept your admission to the program on BuckeyeLink through your **Applicant Center**. You are required to accept or deny your offer of admission within two weeks.
- Early Admission BSN Pathway students:** Students admitted through the Early Admission Pathway do not have to accept their offer of admission into the nursing major. Instead, your major will change to nursing once our office confirms whether or not you have met the progression requirements. This review will occur in mid-to-late May.
