- Collaborative, interdisciplinary hub as one stop shop to support research
- Specialize in a variety of areas including data management and visualization, digital humanities, etc.; Growing and trying to find out what researchers on campus need and how the Research Commons can help to meet those needs
- Supports students in a variety of disciplines; mostly focused on grad/prof students, but open to undergrads and others; online students can access services
- Space-3<sup>rd</sup> floor of 18<sup>th</sup> Ave. library with small meeting rooms, open study computer lab with varied software, digital whiteboards, etc.; can reserve rooms online
- Services
  - Consultation hours – students can schedule 1-on-1 consultations via online calendar
  - Workshops – 45 workshops this semester with variety of topics (see website calendar); in the process of doing webinars and making recordings available online
  - Help students with their research project; point in the right direction, connect to databases and resources at any point in the research
- Potentially coming soon: online forum, trying to foster interdisciplinary work across campus
