- Social gatherings: how to communicate value/increase participation in AGPA

 - Mining OSU Today for potential events to request AGPA trainings
 - Today there was a news item related to DACA in OSU Today
 - Potentially reference the OSU Today events (i.e. we will be bringing this person to an AGPA meeting, etc.).
 - Using RSVP for meetings or events, trying to get people to commit to coming.
 - People could RSVP and get a calendar invite (Outlook)
- Creating workshops that are related to specific topics (financials, GA hiring) or use meetings to have several topics and breakout groups will cover one specific topic
 - o Covers ground on different job types; since membership has different roles and expertise
- Concern about losing attendance with hyper-specific topics; use broad themes and then have breakout sessions; make meetings universal but specific
 - Membership list, listed by Job duties/Program/Department
- Use of blog rather than email listserv, so that answers are sitting there/searchable answers rather than repeatedly asking questions through emails (useful for new staff)
- Onboarding varies by department; specific resources to Grad/Prof people that may be in a department focused on undergraduate
- Increase online learning, webinars; potentially do call-in meetings, modules
- Professional development book club: College of Public Health does one off-campus and has read books like *iGen* (Jean Twenge), *Grit* (Angela Duckworth) (PH group meets every three months)
 - o Would create impetus to use scholarly articles and to retain information on them
 - Inside Graduate Admissions (Julie R. Posselt) book, covered many problems in how graduate students are admitted
- Contact different professional development groups to inquire about reduced rates, and also reserve seats for different speakers, would raise awareness of AGPA
 - Ohio Diversity in Leadership conference is an example
- Times of meetings/rooms
 - Looking to alternate times (a.m./p.m.) and keep meetings monthly/third Thursday
 - o Requests input if you have a space in your building for 35-50 people
- Recalibrate the AGPA membership list; find out who is attending regularly; find out if certain topics/locations/times draw bigger crowd; figure out if there are outreach opportunities/we are reaching everyone
- Interest in meeting with the new Dean of the Graduate School, having a town hall with the group potentially
- Potentially doing a community service project off campus; educational outreach to schools potentially
- Interest in outreach related to higher education; educating students about graduate school
- Provide a campus resources refresher/remind or introduce people to what is available at OSU.
