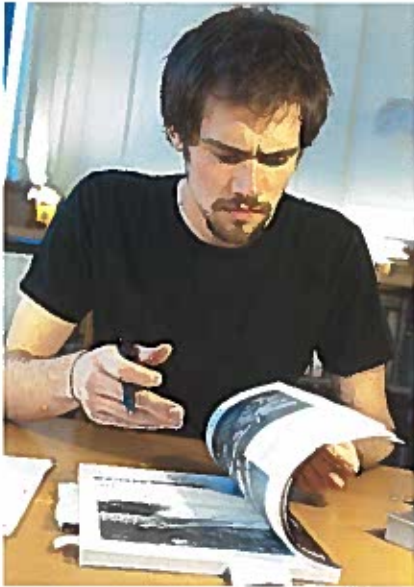

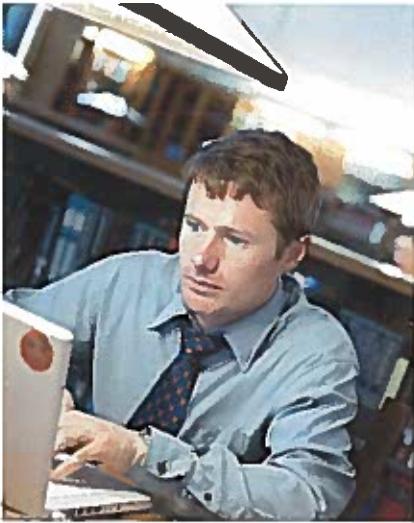

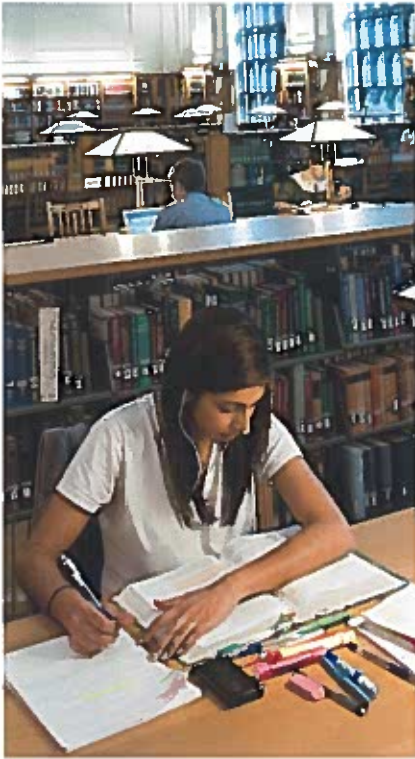

- Items not available through the OSU or OhioLINK catalogs that are needed for scholarly research can be obtained through Interlibrary Services. [go.osu.edu/interlibraryservices](http://go.osu.edu/interlibraryservices)
- A print collection of more than seven million volumes
- Loan periods of 17 weeks with unlimited renewals for books from the University Libraries collection [go.osu.edu/libcirc](http://go.osu.edu/libcirc)
