



# Agricultural Fertilizer Applicator Certification

## 3-hour training for new fertilizer applicators

**FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 10 – 1:00 PM - 4:00 PM**

A three-hour fertilizer certification program will be held in Kenton for any private or commercial applicator who needs to obtain fertilizer certification for the first time. This training will be held at the Hardin County OSU Extension office, 1021 W Lima Street, Kenton, Ohio on Friday, February 10. The class will begin at 1:00 pm and end at 4:00 pm. There is a \$30 class fee payable to OSU Extension for this training. Register no later than a week before the class. Upon successful completion, applicator will be able to apply for certification with the Ohio Department of Agriculture.
