Graduate and Professional Students:

- Available for OSU graduate/professional school students pursuing a course of study requiring advanced foreign language and area studies training
- Must be full-time student and U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Summer Fellowships: \$2,500 stipend and up to \$5,000 in tuition/fee support
- Academic Year Fellowships: \$15,000 stipend and up to \$18,000 in tuition/fee support

Undergraduate Students:

- Available for OSU undergraduate students of junior or senior standing in a science, technology, engineering, or mathematics (STEM) field who have successfully completed two years of college-level East Asian language study
- Must be full-time student and U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Summer Fellowships: **\$2,500** stipend and up to **\$5,000** in tuition/fee support
- Academic Year Fellowships: \$5,000 stipend and up to \$10,000 in tuition/fee support
