

SUMMER PROGRAM FOR UNDERREPRESENTED STUDENTS



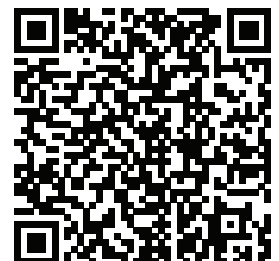
- A summer of intensive research training in an NHLBI laboratory in Bethesda, MD
