Francisco is founder and Director of the 'Centro UC de Cambio Global-CCG', an interdisciplinary Center within PUC, composed of faculty and graduate students from Biology, Agronomy, Geography, Engineering and Economics. He is a member of SSC of the Global Water System Project and the IPCC TGICA and has served as guest editor of Climate Change. Francisco holds a PhD in

Atmospheric Science from Cornell University.
