When editing the quiz in Chrome with the Proctorio plug-in installed, be sure to select "Enable Procotorio Secure Exam Proctor" which appears under the "Details" tab when editing a quiz:




Once enabled, a third tab will appear at the top of the quiz called "Proctorio Settings":

▼ Recording Options






Record Video will capture video from the webcam for the entire exam, giving insight to the test taker's exam environment.








These options determine what will be verified prior to the exam.








This option allows test takers to use a scratch pad on-screen




These behavior settings allow you to set the weight of suspicious behaviors using preset configurations.

When you are finished editing the settings, click "Save" at the bottom of the page.

Moderate This Quiz

Now that you are out of editing mode, you have the option to "Moderate This Quiz" on the right side of the screen:



This is where you can see whether or not students have attempted the quiz, and how long it took them to complete. You can also manually unlock the quiz for students individually, or adjust the testing time as needed for individual students.

With Proctorio enabled, at the bottom of the page you will have the option to "MAKE EXAM FLEXIBLE":

If an exam is made flexible, then test takers will have the option to use Proctorio or take the exam with an approved proctor who has the exam password. Learn more about exam flexibility e^a .

Proctorio can also be disabled for certain test takers. If Proctorio is disabled for an individual, then they must take the exam at the testing center, and cannot use Proctorio.



By clicking "Make Exam Flexible" Proctorio will generate a password that you then provide to the OSU testing center. Copy and paste this password and provide it on the OSU Testing Center request form:
