
SUPPLIES & EQUIPMENT

PEN & BEDDING



A 6' by 10' size pen is enough room for one pig. If possible try to only have one pig per pen so you can keep better track of how much feed each is eating

We made our pens with pallets and they worked great! You don't need to go out and buy a really fancy setup, whatever you can do works

PEN & BEDDING

I would recommend the "Flake" over the "Fine" shavings

Before putting down your bedding each time, spray the floor and walls of your pen with an insect control. This helps to controls flies and other insects that could bite your hog and leave marks

If you get your pigs when it is still chilly, I would suggest to mix sawdust and straw together to give them some extra warmth. You could also put a heat lamp on if needed



Shampoo

Try to only wash with soap once a week.

Shampooing your hog every day will take too many natural oils out of the skin and hair

Medicated Shampoo

To take precautionary measures, it's a good idea to shampoo your hog with a medicated shampoo a few days before a show and a few days once back home from a show to protect their hide & hair



Show Day Prep

SHOW PREP

A FEW DAYS BEFORE SHOW

- *OPTIONAL*
 - CLIP THE HEAD
 - This can be done with a very short guard (3/16th size)
 - Once the head is clipped blend a little ways back into the neck with a bigger guard
 - CLIP A LITTLE OVER THE TOP
 - Use a guard! (recommend 9/16-11/16th guard)
 - We normally only do this if they are super hairy
 - EVERYONE HAS THEIR STYLE OF CLIPPING-HERE IS A FEW VIDEOS TO HELP:

SHOW PRESHOW

- WASH WITH SHAMPOO
 - (Whitening soap if there is white on your pig)
- USE A CONDITIONER AND LET SIT FOR A FEW MINUTES BEFORE RINSING
- MAKE SURE TO BRUSH FOR A FEW MINUTES ALL OVER AFTER TO LAY ALL THE HAIR DOWN
 - Dont forget the belly and legs!

If conditioned correctly throughout the summer, water from the sprayer will be enough to make them glisten!

OIL SHOWS

- WHIP

- PAN OR CLIP ON FEEDERS
- FEED & SUPPLEMENTS
- HOSE
- SHAMPOO/WHITENING SHAMPOO
- CONDITIONERS AND OILS (IF PERMITTED)
- BRUSHES & RAGS
- PITCHFORK
- SHAVINGS
- ZIP TIES
- PAPER TOWELS
- PEN DIVIDERS (IF NEEDED)

At Home & In the Ring

TRAINING AT HOME

• START AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE


The younger they are, the easier it will be

• START OFF SLOW

 You don't need to drive them the first few times they are out-just get them used to the feeling of the whip, you can even just sit in the yard with them


• IF THEY NEED HELP GETTING OUT OF THE BARN TRY:

- Coaxing them with feed or marshmallows/peppermints
- Let them naturally come out themselves
- Use hog boards as a last resort




- AFTER A WEEK OR SO, YOU CAN START WORKING WITH YOUR HOG TO GET THEM TO DRIVE LIKE THIS
 - WORK THEM SLOWLY UP TO 45 MIN. - 1 HR. EACH DAY

Getting your show pig to do all of this effortlessly is going to take some time. With hard work and determination you will get there. Don't give up!



WHAT TO KNOW FOR SHOWMANSHIP DAY

- EAR NOTCH OF YOUR HOG
 - LEFT EAR=LITTER NUMBER
 - RIGHT EAR=PIG NUMBER
- PEDIGREE OF YOUR HOG
 - SIRE & DAM
 - EX: CRUEL INTENTIONS X KING COBRA
- WEIGHT & BIRTH DATE
 - WEIGHT IF MARKET ANIMAL
 - BIRTH DATE IF BREEDING ANIMAL
- WHAT YOU LIKE/DISLIKE ABOUT YOUR HOG
 - EX PROS: RIB SHAPE, WIDTH, & STOUT FEATURE (BONE)
 - EX CONS: COULD BE MORE EXTENDED OR SOUNDER



This is information that is always helpful and good to know about your project-just be sure to know them for showmanship day
