This fee covers your book, shells, targets and the use of a shotgun. Each participant will be required to provide their own eye and hearing protection.

Meeting Agenda:

- Review the Ohio 4-H Shooting Sports Curriculum and define expectations for the project.
- Review the training and practice schedule..
- Provide the necessary paperwork, answer any questions you may have and complete the first session.

Project Guidelines:

- Each participant is expected to attend at least four of the first five meetings to insure a complete understanding of the safety and operational curriculum. The final five meetings are primarily for hands on reinforcement of safety, training, and shooting technique through the actual use of a shotgun. Participants are strongly encouraged to attend every meeting. It is expected that each participant will attend a minimum of seven sessions to complete the project. Parents are invited to attend our meetings.
- Participants must be a minimum of 9 years old as of January 1st, 2024, enrolled in a county 4-H club, and meet all 4-H club requirements.
- Participants are required to bring eye and ear protection starting at the 3rd meeting.
- Participants must complete the project book and project judging.

Paperwork

Some rules

- 1. Proper clothing is required for safe shooting.
- 2. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated.
- 3. We may need the assistance of a parent while practicing shooting skills.
- 4. You can use your own shotgun **ONLY IF** it is safe to shoot, and you understand and can demonstrate the proper operation of your shotgun to the instructor. Sharing of personal firearms is not allowed.

Project Completion

- 1. You must attend at least 4 of the first 5 meetings and at least 3 of the final 5 meetings. Under special circumstances arrangements may be made with the instructor to make up a class.
- 2. You must complete the project book and complete project judging.
