Why Keep Records?

The purpose of 4-H record keeping is to teach how to keep records, which is an important life skill. Recordkeeping is an ongoing process that does not end when the 4-H year ends. Youth are encouraged to select from a variety of alternatives to meet their individual recordkeeping needs and learning styles.

Records Help You...

- → To learn how to set goals, how to make plans for action, and how to decide how well you did (evaluation).
- → Learn about animals, their rate of growth, the feed they require, the cost of the feed, and your animal's habits
- → Plan and budget future projects
- → Follow drug withdrawal times and keep a record of all medications/ or treatments given
- → Know if you made or lost money, and how much
- → Improve your management practices
- → Keep a record of your project activities
- → Understand the business aspects and economics of purchasing animals, feed, facilities, and equipment for an animal project

Remember, records are no more useful than what you put into them.


