Hi Patrick,

The handbook is closely aligned with strategies that are already being used at FMS, so it should be fairly easy to gain consensus and buy-in from the staff. A couple of changes have come from AVID, the most notable that should be revised in your handbook - Cornell Notes has been revised to structured notetaking and can now include multiple forms, Cornell being one of them. I encourage you to visit the website to get details.

I do think you will have a more difficult time with PBL based on teacher style, you might not get the consensus or buy-in you want from this strategy. You may want to consider Design Thinking where you test prototypes and it can be done within lessons not through units. Colorado Education Initiative has a wide variety of resources to help with this - PBL is a large and time intensive strategy. But I leave that decision up to you.
