Guidelines and Application for the Jerry Krebs Honorary Scholarship

In an effort to honor the volunteerism of Jerry Krebs and to recognize the youth of Clermont County, the Clermont County 4-H Advisory Committee has put forth the Jerry Krebs Honorary Scholarship. The purpose of this scholarship is to financially assist high school seniors, and/or first year graduates who are continuing their education at an accredited institution in any field. This scholarship is open to Clermont County, Ohio 4-H members. This is a nonrenewable scholarship awarded in the amount of \$500.

Guidelines

- *The applicant must be a high school senior, or a graduate continuing their education at an accredited institution.
- *Individuals must not be older than 18 years of age as of January 1, of the current year and must have served as an active participant in the Clermont County 4-H program during that year.
- * Applicants must complete a minimum of one project during the year of application.
- *Applicants must have been an active member in Clermont County 4-H for a minimum of 4 years.
- *All questions on the application form must be answered to be considered for an award.
- *High school and/or college transcripts must be attached. Unofficial transcripts are acceptable but must be signed by a high school counselor.
- *One letter of recommendation should be submitted from someone who can evaluate your character and 4-H participation.

Applications will be judged on the following basis: Scholastic Standing 20%

Citizenship and Leadership 20%

Essays 30%

4-H Participation 30%

The scholarship recipient will be announced and must be present at Winner's Circle. It will be awarded after the successful completion (GPA 2.5 or higher) of the first grading period.
