

## Ohio State Fair 4-H Livestock Judging Contest Instructions

### Contents of packet received at registration:

- Contestant number (on a white, sticky nametag), which must be always worn visibly on your shirt.
- One Scantron per contestant with their contestant number on the top, right corner.

### Items you can have with you:

- Items in the packet you received at registration along with provided class scenarios and data.
- Pencils – #2 pencils for scantron sheets and taking notes.
- Pens – Must be blue or black ink; can be used to take notes.
- Notebook/paper – Plain paper/blank notebook may be used for writing reasons and/or to keep track of your class placings.
- **Clipboard – Needed to fill out the scantron sheet.**
- Face mask

### Items you cannot have with you:

- Study materials and resources
- Cell phones or any other electronic devices
- Apparel (shirts, jackets, belt buckles, etc.) that distinguishes in any manner who you are or where you are from (i.e., individuals name, 4-H club, county, etc.)

### Contest instructions:

- JUNIORS – Place up to 8 classes, answer 3 sets of questions in front of animals, and give 1 sets of oral reasons.
- SENIORS – Place up to 8 classes, answer 1 set of blind questions, and give 4 sets of oral reasons.
- Do not start judging a class or continue to another class until instructed by an official.
- No talking. Violators may be removed from the contest. If you have a question, ask your group leader. Avoid standing or sitting next to teammates during the contest.
- Scantrons must be turned into your group leader when all questions are completed. Late scantrons will not be accepted and contestants will be disqualified. It is not the group leader's responsibility to make sure your scantron is completed correctly. If it is not, then you will receive a zero for the class scores.

### Placing a class:

- You have 8 class placing columns on a scantron sheet. You may want to write which species corresponds with the class number in your notes.
- The columns containing numbers 1 through 24 are your placing options. Four animals in each pen will be numbered 1 through 4.
- Once you have placed the animals in order from top to bottom, clearly mark the placing with a dark circle on your scantron. Make sure only ONE placing is marked per column. If multiple answers are marked, it will be scored as a zero. See an example on the right.

### Questions:

- Use a #2 PENCIL ONLY! Using a pen will result in a zero score.
- Fill in or darken ONE circle per line corresponding to each question.
- If you change your answer, be sure to fully erase your original choice. Not fully erasing your choice can lead to errors in scoring. Questions with multiple answers will be scored as incorrect.
- You will answer the questions while you are judging the class.
- You will answer either 5 or 10 questions on each species.
- For your answers:
  - Letter A/Number 1 corresponds to animal #1
  - Letter B/Number 2 corresponds to animal #2
  - Letter C/Number 3 corresponds to animal #3
  - Letter D/Number 4 corresponds to animal #4

**Oral reasons (SENIORS and JUNIORS):**

- There are NO reasons cards in the packet. Take notes while you are judging the class about the animals to remember when preparing for your oral reasons.
- Write down how you placed the class. You will NOT get your scantron back to prepare for oral reasons.
- Reasons officials will have a score sheet with your contestant number on it. They only know who you are by that number/letter combination. **Wear your number on your shirt throughout the contest.**
- **DO NOT** fill in the Reasons box on the righthand column. See example above.
