Register for Courses

Enrollment appointments for upcoming semesters are posted in your <u>BuckeyeLink</u>Student Center. You can register for courses as soon as your enrollment appointment opens. Autumn semester enrollment appointments begin the third week of March.

You should plan to register for autumn semester courses as soon as possible. Your assigned curriculum plan is available in <u>Beacon</u>. Please use your name.# only to log in. I will regularly audit enrollment to confirm you are in the correct courses and will email you directly if any specific action on your end is required.

The <u>College of Nursing Graduate Orientation</u> event for incoming graduate students will be held online on August 15, 2024. Attendance is strongly encouraged.
