

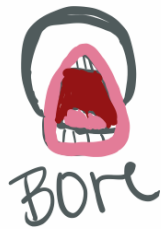

Amuse vs. Bore

Our first idea for amuse vs bore is to create an extension of the face. These will be comprised on one of us as a exaggerated, large mouth that is laughing. This will be the focus on "amuse". We planned on attaching this with a stand that will be connected with a stand or string. We planned on making this out of Bristol paper. The other person will have the "bore" extension of the face, which would be a mouth that appears to be yawning. The idea of the other sense is that we will create the noise of either of the extensions, by laughing or yawning to create noise.
