BSA serves students and families in Columbus by providing academic support and healthy living programming. In addition to afterschool programs, this year they offer a location for remote learning.

WHAT I DID:

Throughout fall semester, I served as a virtual volunteer for BSA. Each Friday, I joined the program through Zoom, where I met with the program director, created a promotional video for the program, and interacted with students.

ABOUT THE AGENCY:

The Columbus Dream Center serves the needs of low-income, homeless, and underserved people in Columbus. During the pandemic, they serve students through learning extension centers (LEC). LEC provides a safe space with internet access, meals, and tutoring for students learning online this school year.

WHAT I DID:

January through March, I served at the LEC for 3-4 hours each Monday and Friday. I rode along in the van to pick up students from their homes, helped serve a meal, tutored and encouraged students to finish their work, and ensured students returned safely to their homes.
