Interpreting Ohio Wildlife Council Proposed Changes to Coyote Hunting and Trapping

TUESDAY, FEB. 18, 2020 6-8 P.M.

On January 15, 2020, new proposals including requiring a fur taker permit for coyote hunting and trapping and adding coyote to the furbearer trapping season were proposed to the Ohio Wildlife Council. Ohio resident landowners would not be required to have a hunting license or fur taker permit when hunting or trapping on land they own. We will discuss the logic and structure behind the proposal and how to submit public comments to the Ohio Wildlife Council which are open for submission beginning on Feb. 21, 2020.
