#### **Maternity and Nursery**


- Work in team environment with staff to meet live birth goals and adhere to birth protocols as established by The Ohio Heifer Center

- Deliver all bottles to all calves
- · Assist any calf having difficulty eating
- Follow washing protocol
- Identify and treat sick calves
- · Check water—replace if soiled
- Check grain—replace if soiled
