State 4-H Junior Shooting Sports Camp

June 23-25, 2023

The Licking County 4-H Committee, in partnership with the Licking County 4-H Shooting Sports Committee, will be choosing two 4-H members, who are currently completing Grades 3-6, to participate in State 4-H Junior Shooting Sports Camp. State 4-H Junior Shooting Sports Camp is a residential camp, and will be held at Canter's Cave 4-H Camp in Jackson, Ohio during June 23-25, 2023.

Licking County 4-H members interested in applying must meet the following criteria:

- Active 4-H member during 2023 4-H project year
- Be currently completing grades 3-6
- Submit completed Achievement Award Form by the deadline (Monday, May 22nd)
- Be available to participate in June 23-25, 2023 camp, and provide travel to camp event in Jackson, Ohio

Cost: The total cost of the trip is \$250. The Licking County 4-H Shooting Sports Committee, in cooperation with the Licking County 4-H Committee, will cover 50% of registration costs for two delegates. The delegate will be responsible for \$125.

Licking County 4-H delegates will be chosen based upon their involvement in the Licking County 4-H program (as noted in their application). All applications must be received in the Licking County Extension Office no later than 4:30 p.m. on Monday, April 21st in order to be considered for selection.

The Ohio 4-H Shooting Education Camps are fun-filled learning experiences for campers in grades 3-12. Offering two age-appropriate camps both held at Canter's Cave 4-H Camp. The junior level 3-day camp, is specifically for campers in grades 3-6, who would like to experience basic shooting sports disciplines including: *Archery, Shotgun, Pistol, Rifle, Hunting & Wildlife, and Living History*. The Senior level 6-day camp, is for teens in grades 7-12. It offers basic and advanced disciplines including *Beginner Archery, Action Archery, Beginner Rifle, Rifle Sport, Rifle Marksmanship, Beginner Shotgun, Shotgun Sports, Basic Pistol, Steel Rifle/Pistol, Living History and Hunting & Wildlife*. Both camps focus on the safe, responsible, ethical use of firearms and archery equipment. Shooting instruction is led by trained, experienced 4-H Shooting Sports Instructors. Campers will select one shooting discipline to focus on while at camp. They will also have opportunities to sample other disciplines along with fun traditional camping activities such as crafts, boating, fishing, hiking and more. All activities are conducted under the direct supervision of our trained instructors and 4-H staff.
