

September 30 is the deadline for those wanting to receive their fertilizer applicator certification. The state of Ohio has mandated that anyone spreading commercial fertilizer on 50 total acres of crops that will be sold off of the farm will be required to obtain this certification. This includes hay and field crops. Those using the crops for their own farm are exempt.

If you have a valid pesticide applicators license, you are required to complete 2 hours of the training. All others are required to attend all 3 hours. There is currently no testing required to receive the certification. Rules could change in the future and those who wait may have to take a test in order to be certified. The certification is valid for 3 years.
