


Snakes, Oh My!

What should you know about venomous and non-venomous snakes?

How Can You Tell The Difference? Check out this chart to spot some signs!



Did You Know? Non-venomous snakes are also called **constrictors** because they squeeze their prey instead of biting them. The corn snake (pictured below) is a common Ohio constrictor.



Help! I've Been Bitten By a Venomous Snake!


If you are bitten by a venomous snake...

- Seek immediate medical attention
- Take a photograph of snake if possible
- Wash affected area
- Draw a ring around the affected area and write the time of the bite

What About Ohio? We only have **3** venomous snake species here in Ohio:

- Northern Copperhead (pictured on the right)
- Eastern Massasauga
- Timber Rattlesnake

Venomous vs. Constrictor Snake Species



Nothing (Much) To Be Afraid Of! Venomous snakes only make up about **13%** of snake species in the world.
