but whether you get back up.





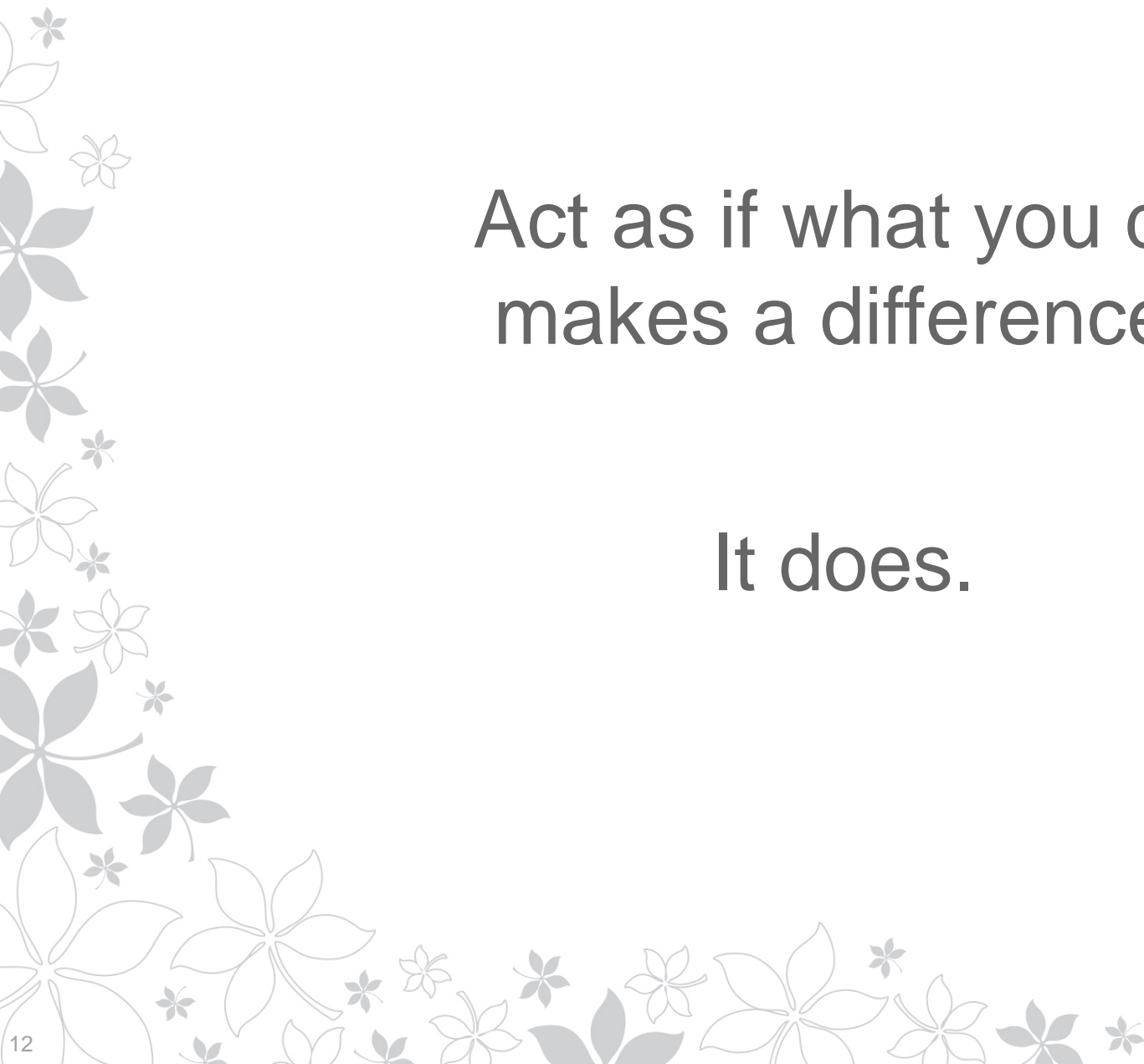
