Pullorum School Requirements

The Ohio Poultry Association (official state agency, NPIP) and the Ohio Department of Agriculture are combining efforts to organize Pullorum-Fowl Typhoid plate agglutination tester training classes. Whether your certification is due to expire or you have expressed interest in becoming a newly certified Pullorum tester, we are inviting you to participate in the training program. You must be 18 years of age to become a certified tester.

There is a charge of \$50 per student to offset program costs. There is an additional \$5 fee for first time participants. Your certification is valid for 5 years. If your certification is due to expire in 2016, you will need to attend this training to maintain certification. If this is your first time being certified, you will physically test a bird, A BIRD WILL BE PROVIDED FOR YOU. DO NOT BRING ANY POULTRY TO THE FAIRGROUNDS. Each person needs to please *bring a lawn chair* to class as chairs will not be provided.

Pullorum Testing Equipment
