Factor 1. Families

"A child's learning and socialization are most influenced by their family since the family is the child's primary social group"

 Parents who use drugs, are in poverty, and/or have lack of extended support, are just a few examples of factors that can potentially negatively influence child development and behavior. Children are influenced in more ways than you think! Model healthy practices.

 Obviously, utilizing childcare does not necessarily mean your child will regress in development or become insecurely attached. Understandably, many parents have to both work to financially provide for their family. Ensure your childcare center is adequate and high quality in promoting your child's development!
