TAR HOLLOW WATERFRONT RULES FOR CAMPERS AND COUNSELORS

Swimming Area:

- You may not enter the beach area unless a life guard is on duty
- Must have a buddy and stay with buddy at all times
- No running
- No diving
- No horseplay
- No playing in the yellow ropes
- Any swim times lasting more than 60 minutes must have a 10 minute rest period

Water Slide:

- A counselor or adult must be stationed at the top of the slide
- No diving, running, standing, kneeling, rotating, tumbling or stopping in the tunnel
- Must travel feet first
- One person at a time; no groups or chains
- Keep all parts of the body within the tunnel
- Leave the exit area promptly; meet back up with assigned buddy
- Bathing suits only

Boating Area:

- You may not enter the beach area unless a lifeguard is on duty
- Everyone must have a PFD (personal flotation device) properly fitted, checked and on their bodies at all times when in boats
- No tipping boats
- Only one person per kayak
- Canoes with all campers age 11 and under must have a counselor with them
