**Step 1:** Initial interview and training: in person or on-line (60-90 mins)



**Step 2:** Complete a survey via phone daily for 30 days (5 mins each survey)



**Step 3:** Final interview and feedback: in-person or on-line (60 mins)

### What the study is about?

Results may help develop programs and services that enhance leisure participation among adults with autism.
