- **1.** Run a Degree Audit on your top major It will show you what you have yet to complete
- 2. Search options for needed GE categories https://ehe.osu.edu/ugss/scheduling/course-search/
- 3. Find classes to help you explore interests
 Gaining insight into your top major ideas is more
 important for degree progress than completing your
 GEs, which just need to be completed by graduation
- 4. Use Schedule Planner to plan schedule
 Run this right when your window opens; send your
 favorite schedule to Quick Enroll to add classes
- Follow up with an advisorCheck with advisor for ideas based on your plan
