



This was a design

Aloof and independent




This was my first idea of how to represent independence from a topic relation—Ship (I chose to abstract the body parts a little more and got rid of the third eye to be respectful of other cultures)

This represents a strong and confident mind that protects from outside forces






With the tinsel that covers the body, the viewer can see that first you must be strong minded and distance yourself from bad so then you can be enoutful in self-love.
