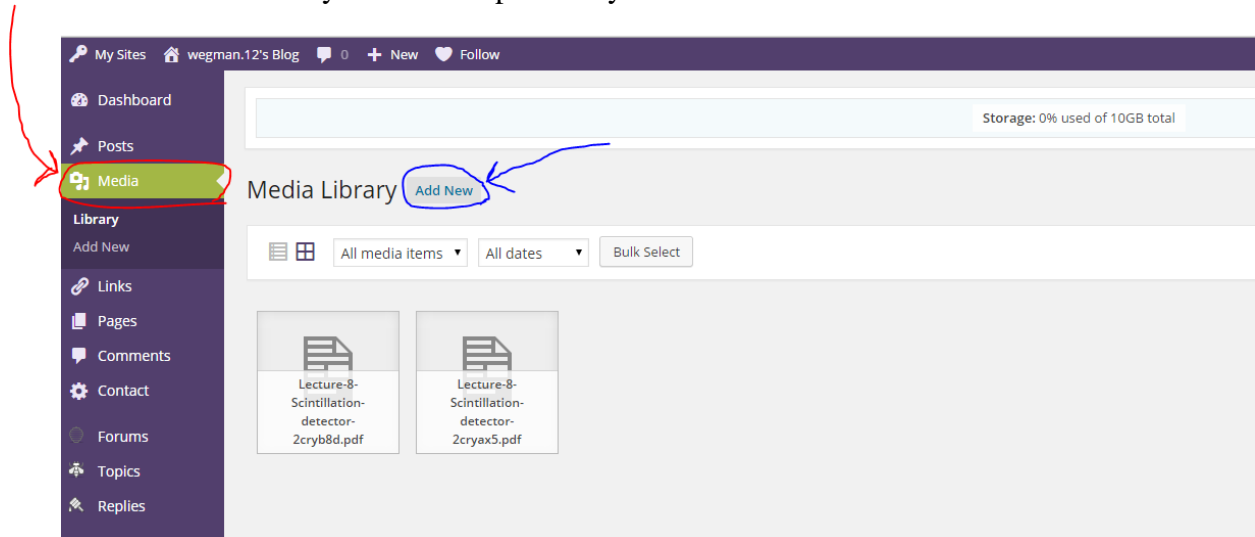


How to Embed Documents on u.osu.edu

This tutorial will teach the user how to embed pdf documents on a u.osu.edu site using iframe, an html plugin that allows documents to be embedded (source: http://www.w3schools.com/tags/tag_iframe.asp). Follow these steps to embed any document on your u.osu.edu site!

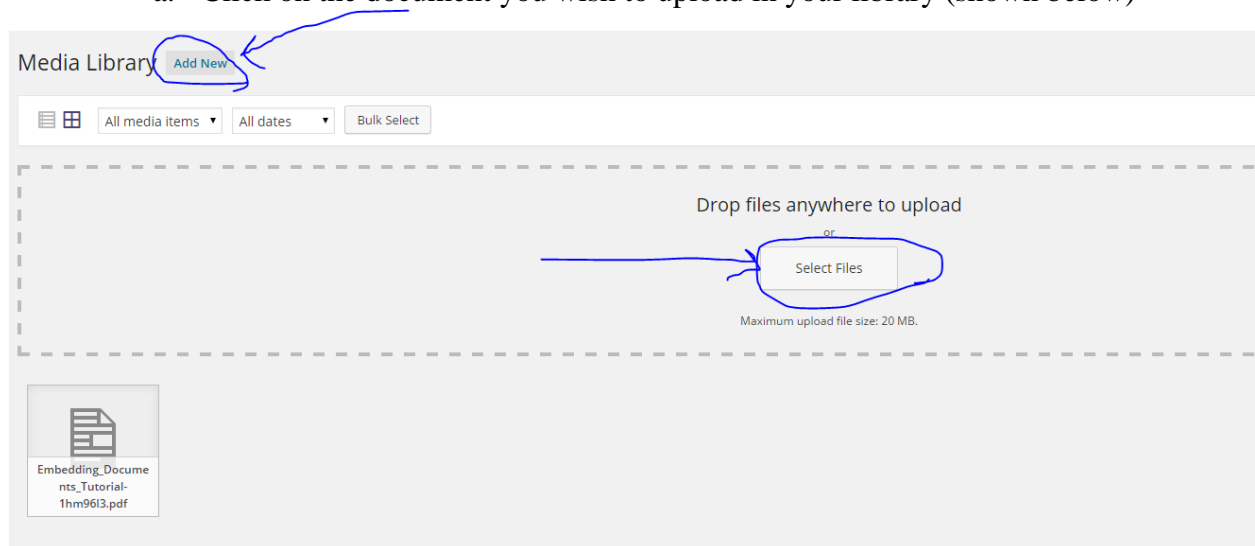
1. Add the file that you wish to upload to your media folder on the dashboard



- a. Click on the media tab on your page's dashboard (red line above)
- b. Click "Add New" (blue line above)
- c. Select the file you would like to upload

2. Copy the link that your document is now associated with

- a. Click on the document you wish to upload in your library (shown below)

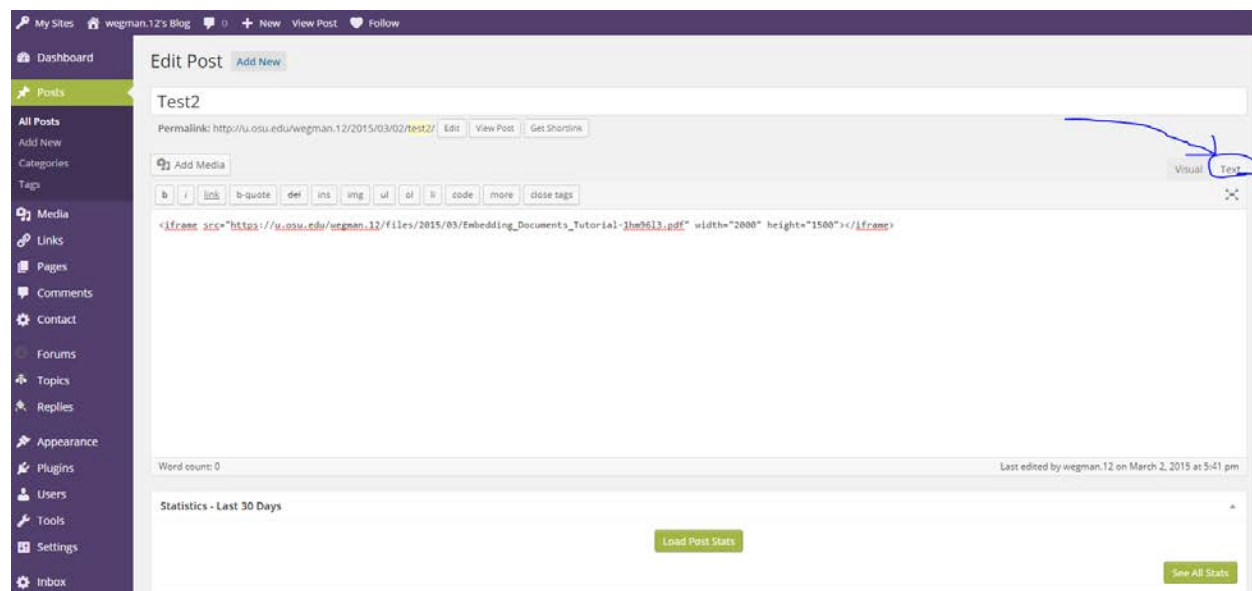


- b. The document will appear in your media library. Click on the document, and copy the URL of the document



3. Place embedded URL code into your post
- Edit or add the post you would like to add the embedded document to.
 - Select the “Text” option (shown in the picture below) and paste in the following text **with your filename link inserted** (Replace “YOURFILENAMELINKHERE” with the link from step 2).

<iframe src="YOURFILENAMELINKHERE" width="2000" height="1500"></iframe>
```



- c. Save your changes and update the post (click publish/update)

If you followed these steps, your document should now be embedded on your post. Verify by viewing the post from your site.
